### Reading at Roby Park:

I have enjoyed the opportunity to work with groups of children across the school this week and discuss their thoughts on reading and listen to them read. It has been lovely to hear how positive the children feel about reading, particularly our boys. ***Something I would like to see improve is the number of children who are reading at home regularly.*** Children in all classes need to read at home to an adult at least 3-4 times a week to practice and improve their reading skills and vocabulary. Once a child has read at home, the adult must sign their planner or reading record and return the book to school. **It is important that every child has their reading book in school every day** so that it can be changed for a new book or so an adult can hear a child read. Reading is such an important life skill and by home and school working together, we can achieve better outcomes for our children. Thank you for your support!
