Parent/Carer Survey Results 2016:

Thank you to our parents/carers who took the time to complete our annual questionnaire at our Parents' Evening in October. The results have been analysed and I am delighted to share the following comments with you:

- 100% of parents and carers are happy with the standard of teaching at Roby Park
- 100% of our families feel that their child is safe at Roby Park
- 96% of parents/carers say their child enjoys coming to school
- 100% of families believe that our rules and sanctions are fair
- 98% of parents and carers feel that they are made to feel welcome in school
- 98% of families feel that their child is making good progress in school
- 100% of parents and carers say that that they are kept well informed of school/class events and information
- 100% of families are happy with how their concerns are dealt with by school staff
- 98% of families are happy with the help and support their child receives in school

We received some wonderful, positive comments from the parents/carers who completed the surveys and these comments have been put up on display in the school entrance and on our website. The staff and governors are delighted with the responses which I personally feel reflect all of the hard work and support that we invest in our pupils and demonstrate what good relationships we have as home and school in order to achieve better outcomes for our children.

As well as receiving such positive feedback, the Senior Management Team have also been looking at some constructive points that we received in our surveys. These items will be addressed over the coming weeks via letter providing additional information or at our planned Parent Partnership meeting for January.
