



Roby Park Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 1 Autumn - 2018

English

This half term the children will be:

- Continuing with their personalised letters and sounds programme.
- Learning about labels and captions, and how they give us information.
- Making labelled plans and diagrams, and adding captions.
- Describing familiar settings, such as school, in discussion and writing.
- listening, reading and responding to stories with familiar settings
- Recount linked to stories with familiar settings.
- Reading songs and poems, joining in with familiar phrases and words.
- Learning the days of the week.

PE

The children will be taking part in indoor PE lessons this half term - practising the basics of running, jumping, throwing and catching, and also taking part in team games. Children should have a full PE kit in school. This will stay in school until half term.

Science, History, Geography, Art, D&T and ICT

- **Computing** - We are all connected - using the internet and understanding the internet - how to use eBooks.
- **Science** - Animals including humans Ourselves, using our senses, identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body. Saying which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- **Topic** - Behaviour for Learning animal - The Bee children will be learning to be part of a team.
- **Art** - printing and pattern - printing with a variety of natural and man-made materials to explore colour, pattern and texture, focusing on the artist Picasso.

Music

Hey you Investigating pulse using the Charanga website. The children will be applying pulse and pitch to learn and perform songs for an audience, during our Christmas production

Mathematics

The children will be focusing on

- Number bonds
- Timetables.
- Sequencing.
- Finding 1 more and 1 less.
- Reading and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.
- Recognising, naming, describing and sorting 2D shapes.
- Using addition facts to help solve subtractions.
- Adding 1,2, and 3 by adding on, and subtract 1,2 and 3 by counting back

PHSE and RE

The children will be celebrating our Harvest of Hands. They will learn to work as a team, find out about the roles and responsibilities of the adults working in our school and discover how we help each other.

Homework

- **English/Maths:** Homework is set to consolidate skills taught in class. Sent out on a Friday to be returned the following Wednesday.
- **Spellings:** Children will receive a spelling list linked to Letters and Sounds/topic to be learnt and tested every half term.
- **Reading:** To be practiced daily. Books are changed Monday and Thursday. Please make sure children have their planners daily as they contain reading records.
