Year 3 Autumn Term 2018

English

- Children will be reading a range of novels by the class author Dick King Smith including *The Hodgeheg*
- Writing biographies and stories based on Dick King Smith stories and our class animal - Unicorns.
- Consolidating year 2 spellings and learning year 3 spelling patterns.
- Weekly dictation and handwriting practice.
- Weekly guided reading sessions using a range of literature to build on and expand reading comprehension skills.

Physical Education

- Games - Everton in the Community will teach a range of P.E. skills and will include mentoring sessions.

Science, History, Geography, Art, D&T and ICT

- **Science - Animals including humans**- children will learn all about the human skeleton and what animals including humans need to survive. They will study the food and nutrient groups along with skeleton types and how muscles work.
- **Art/DT** - Sketching faces, skulls and skeletons using pencil
- **ICT** - Class democracy- children will use a range of ICT skills to present a campaign about how they can help the school community.
- **Humanities - Geography** - countries of the world, cities and their features

Music

- Exploring Sounds.
- Listen, appraise and perform from different genres of music.

Mathematics

- **Number**- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 3 digit number, compare and order numbers to 1000
- **Addition and Subtraction** - Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits mentally and using written methods.
- **Multiplication and Division** -Count in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100
- Solve problems including 'missing number' problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

SMSC and RE

- **RE**- Responsibility, me, the classroom, in school, at home and in the community.
- **SMSC** -. Contributing to the life of the school, understanding and creating rules.

Homework

- **English/Maths**: Homework is set to consolidate skills taught in class. Sent out on a Friday to be returned the following Tuesday.
- **Spellings**: A test each week and new spellings to be learnt given out on a Friday.
- **Reading**: To be practiced daily. Books are changed when necessary.
