Well done to all the children who come to school every day and on time. **Sadly, not one class hit our school attendance target of 97%. Our overall school attendance was 94.3%.**

Families and school must work together to ensure our children are attending school every day. Again, thank you to those parents who attended the attendance panel meetings. To those who did not, the meeting went ahead and the action plans will be in the post shortly.

Where families do not engage with school, they will be referred to the Local Authority attendance team. This week, we will be reviewing those who have had 10 or more unauthorised sessions, in 10 weeks, which will result in a fixed penalty notice letter. If your child has one more unauthorised absence then fixed penalties will be requested,

Please make sure your child is in school at 8.45am. Learning starts as soon as they are in their classroom. Children are missing important learning and are often very embarrassed having to join their class mates late. This has a negative impact on their wellbeing. Registers will close at 9.15am. If your child comes to school after this, it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. If children have 10 unauthorised absences, in the space of 10 weeks, this will trigger a fixed penalty notice request which is **£120** if issued.

Our target is for no more than 5 lates per class, per week. **There were 105 last week!**
