## World Book—7th March

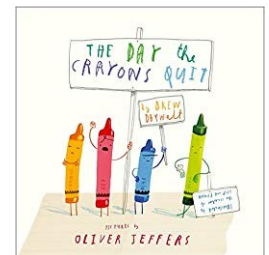
