On the first day back after the holidays, we will be celebrating St George's Day. Children can come to school wearing red and white to mark the occasion.

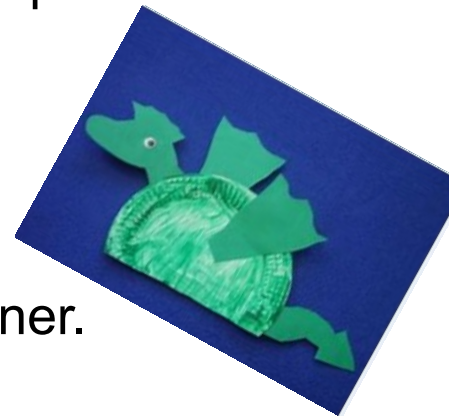
We will have a special morning assembly, taken by Mrs Lyon, before the children embark on a day of arts and crafts.
