Whole school attendance this week is 93.6%. Well done to all those families who are working with us to ensure their children are in school and enjoying learning.

Attendance panel invite letters are going home tonight and meetings will be taking place on 19th June, with Mrs Lyon.

I would like to congratulate all those families who's children do not have attendance over 95% but are working with us to improve the attendance of their children. 76% of families with attendance below 95% have infact improved their child's attendance by working with us. Those who do not work with us, or improve their child's attendance, will receive a warning letter for unauthorised absences and will receive a fine. Further warning letters will also be going out today and if there is no improvement, fines will be issued.

FIXED PENALTY NOTICES

Families with children with 8+ unauthorised absences, in a 10 week period, have received a fixed penalty notice warning letter. Any further unauthorised absences will result in a £120 fine from the Local Authority.

Where attendance continues to be a serious issue, and does not improve, can result in prosecution including £2500 fine, community order or custodial sentence. More information can be found at gov.uk.
