



Roby Park Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 5 Summer 2 - 2016

English

- Reading Ancient Greek Myths and Legends and non-fiction text to enable pupils to research information about the Ancient Greeks.
- Daily opportunities to improve reading skills using taught comprehension skills will be provided across the curriculum. Focus texts on everyday life in Ancient Greece.
- Basic skills - spelling, sentence structure grammar and punctuation as appropriate.
- Writing - "Telling Tales" project which encourages writing through storytelling and drama.

Physical Education

Science, History, Geography, Art, D&T and ICT

- **Science** Healthy eating and dental health
- **DT** - Design and make working models of characters from the Iron Man.

- **History** - A study of The Ancient Greek civilisation.
- **Geography** - Name and locate major land masses on planet earth. Focus on Europe. Name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom.

Mathematics

- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division will be covered on a rolling programme using age related targets as appropriate.
- Mental maths strategies, consolidation of number facts and mathematical vocabulary.
- Pupils will be taught that percentages, decimals and fractions are different ways of expressing proportions.
- Measures such as time and length are taught through topic work and in the context of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
