

Roby Park Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 2 Autumn 1 - 2016

English

This half term we will be learning about Bears who travel, in particular:

- Stories with familiar settings We're Going On A Bear Hunt
- Traditional Stories Goldilocks and the Three Bears
- Information texts Bears, Places to visit
- Poetry Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear and poems by our class author, Julia Donaldson
- Reading for pleasure, Paddington Bear and other bear stories
- Revision of Year 1 Spelling and Phonics

Physical Education

 Sports Coaches - games, team tasks (every Wednesday - full kit required)

Science, History, Geography, Art, D&T and Computing

- Computing Code-tastic, understanding algorithms and debugging
- Science -Living things, Habitats, animals can be grouped according to similarities and differences
- DT Design and make transport using construction kits
- Geography Study a locality visited by Barnaby, name and locate the four countries and capitals of the UK and the seven continents of the world (see planners)
- History Explore a Teddy Bear Museum to order bears by age and find out where the name 'Teddy Bear' comes from.
- Art Colour, shape and pattern. Creating different shades of bear fur, patterns from other places and cultures

Mathematics

This half term we will be learning about Bears who travel, in particular:

- Read, write, compare and order numbers to at least 100 using numerals and in words
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 2-digit number
- Know all Addition and subtraction facts to 10/20 by heart
- Use the inverse relationship between +/and solve problems
- Relate number bonds to 10 to the multiples of ten to 100
- Sorting 2D shapes, symmetry

PSHCE and RE

- Through the topic of Travelling Bears we will examine feelings and emotions to do with going to different places
- New beginnings.
- We will be looking at Families through RE.

French

- Counting to 5
- Basic introductions (hello, my name is...) and feelings (well done, excellent, etc)

Music

- The children will be learning how to play the recorder.
- Identify and create sounds from journeys, sing transport songs

Homework

- English/Maths: Homework is set to consolidate skills taught in class. Sent out on a Monday to be returned on Friday.
- Reading: To be practiced daily. Books are changed on a Monday and Wednesday. Please make sure children have their planners daily as they contain reading records.
