Year 3 Summer 1 - 2016

English

- Focus on reading comprehension, sentence structure and use of vocabulary through stories and poetry.
- Daily opportunities to improve reading skills will be provided across the curriculum.
- Punctuation and sentence structure will be taught with a main focus recapping capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.
- Daily spelling activities focusing on keywords, spelling patterns. Also using spellings in own writing.

Physical Education

- Athletics - All children need their school P.E. kit in school.

French

- I present myself.

Music

- Exploring sounds, rhythm and pitch.

Science, History, Geography, Art, D&T and ICT

- **Science - Forces and Magnets** - investigating different forces acting on an object. Exploring how magnets work and why.
 - **Art/DT** - Create Mosaic pictures and design Roman Armour.
 - **ICT** - research using internet. Create a program using different software.
 - **Humanities - Geography** - Learn about types of settlement and land use, the resources that's people used. Locating countries on a map.
- History** - Learn about changes in Ancient Rome by studying how people lived, homes, clothes, food, tools.

Mathematics

- **Number**- Adding and subtracting mentally and using a paper and pencil methods. Learn target multiplication and division tables.
- **Geometry** - Exploring and investigating 2D and 3D shapes. Finding the angles in 2D shapes.
- **Statistics** - Investigating and interpreting data. Creating own data to analyse.

PSHCE and RE

- **RE**- Looking at different special people.
- **PSHCE** - Relationships- Looking at the different relationships we form. (friends, family, in school, at home.)

Homework

- **English/Maths:** Homework is set to consolidate skills taught in class. Sent out on a Friday to be returned the following Tuesday.
- **Spellings:** A test each week and new spellings to be learnt given out on a Friday.
