



# Roby Park Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 6 Spring 1 - 2016

## English

- Children are given daily opportunities to improve reading skills across the curriculum
- Basic skills - handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- Writing opportunities will be created in throughout the History and Science curriculum.
- Comprehension modelling and skills through written work. Inference and deduction development through visual stimulus.
- Writing - Biography, letter writing and diaries.

## Physical Education

- Gymnastics with external sport coach.

## Arithmetic

- There will be a weekly focus on arithmetic allowing children to become more familiar with SATs style questions.

## Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

- Children will be given regular opportunities to practise spellings, punctuation and grammar.

## Science, History, Geography, Art, D&T and ICT

- **Science** - Evolution and inheritance. How plants and animals have evolved and adapted to their habitats over time.
- **Computing** - ICT will be used to enhance the children's learning across the curriculum.
- **History** - Continuation of crime and punishment from the Romans to the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

## Mathematics

- Basic skills - times tables
- Solving practical problems relating to fractions and decimals.
- Ordering, adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions.
- Using simple formulae.
- Generating and describing linear number sequences.
- Use, read, write and convert between standard units, converting measurements of length, mass, volume and time using decimal notation up to three decimal places.
