Responsible Internet Use



We use the school computers and access the Internet for learning purposes. These rules will help to keep us safe and make sure that everyone is treated fairly.

- I will ask permission before visiting a website, unless my teacher has already told me that the site is safe.
- I will use my own log on name and will not log on as someone else.
- I will only look at my own files. I will not look at, change or delete other people's files.
- I will not bring a memory stick or CD into school to use in school without permission.
- I will only use computers for schoolwork and homework.
- I know that the school may check my computer files and will monitor the Internet sites I visit.
- If anything makes me feel scared or uncomfortable online I will tell a responsible adult straight away.
- If I get a nasty message or get sent something that makes me feel uncomfortable I will not reply and will tell a responsible adult straight away.
- I will not use Internet chat rooms in school.
- I will keep my personal details private. (Name, family information, journey to school, pets and hobbies are all examples of personal details).
- **I understand that if I deliberately break these rules, I may be stopped from using the Internet or computers at school.**
