Nursery, Reception, Y1 & Y2 Races - 9.30-10.30am (approx)

- ✓ Parents, carers and grandparents are welcome to join us to watch the races
- Please enter via the main gate on the Western Avenue entrance and queue up along the footpath leading down to the office and playground so that you can be escorted onto the field once the playground gate is unlocked
- Pupils will take part in traditional yet competitive races such as sprints, egg and spoon and sack races and a few more
- ✓ Nursery and Reception are to wear suitable, comfortable sports wear, Years 1 and 2 pupils must wear their PE kits. All pupils must wear trainers
- Please ensure that your child has sun cream applied before school, brings a water bottle and a cap to wear as they will be outdoors in the sun and heat for approx an hour or even more
- Pupils will be sat with their classes and for health, safety and safegaurding reasons parents/carers will not be permitted to leave their designated viewing area to mingle withthe children we need the session to run smoothly in order to stick to timings so your co-operation will be much appreciated
- ✓ A number of seats will provided for spectators but please feel free to bring along your own chairs if preferred. When all seats are taken, it will be standing room only
- ✓ We will be providing drinks and refreshments for our spectators so please bring along some change to spend.
- Once all of the races have finished pupils will return to class although the Nursery children may return slightly earlier as their races will be run first

- Please enter via the main gate on the Western Avenue entrance and queue up along the footpath leading down to the office and playground so that you can be escorted onto the field once the playground gate is unlocked
