Parking on the Zig Zags!

This week, we have had a number of complaints from staff and parents, as there have been a number of near misses with regards to car accidents and even children almost being knocked down, due to parents parking on the zig zag lines. This is completely unacceptable.

The police and Highways department have been notified and will be regularly patrolling the area. We want to avoid any further issues or even accidents. The registrations of cars parking on the double yellows or zig zags will be noted.

Appointments During the School Day

The advantage of school closing at 3pm, allows for plenty of time for medical appointments (Doctors, Dentist, Opticians etc) to be booked outside of the school day. We appreciate hospital appointments can't be scheduled however we expect all other appointments to be booked outside of the school day.



Medical cards or letters MUST be shown to the office in order for your child to receive an authorised medical mark. If we don't see evidence, it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence. Where we are seeing patterns, you run the risk of receiving a Fixed Penalty Notice. Children are missing out on vital learning and enrichment which is a shame for them and will impact on their learning and wellbeing.

This Friday coming will be our second Celebration Afternoon. Parents are invited into classes to work on an Easter craft with their child at 1.30pm.
