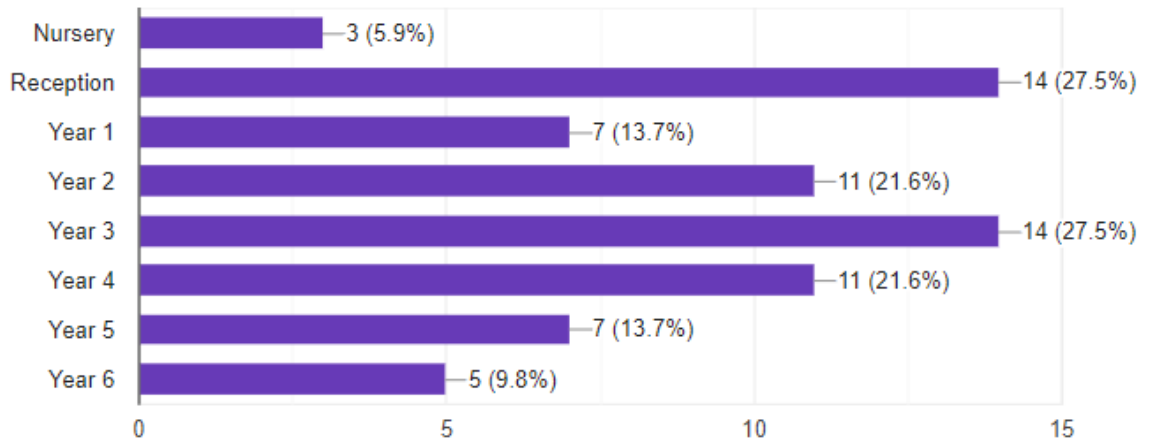


## Roby Park Covid19 Parent Survey

This is a survey to see what is working well and what we can improve on during the Coronavirus outbreak.

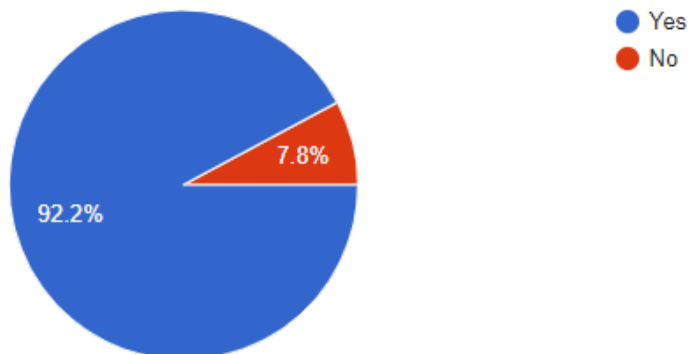
What year group is your child/ren in?

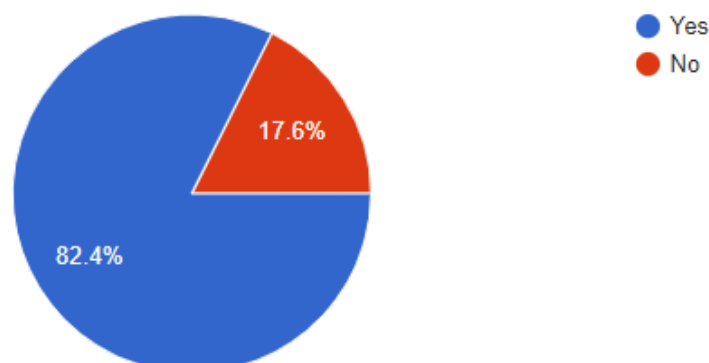
Have you accessed home learning resources and support from the school website and school social media accounts?

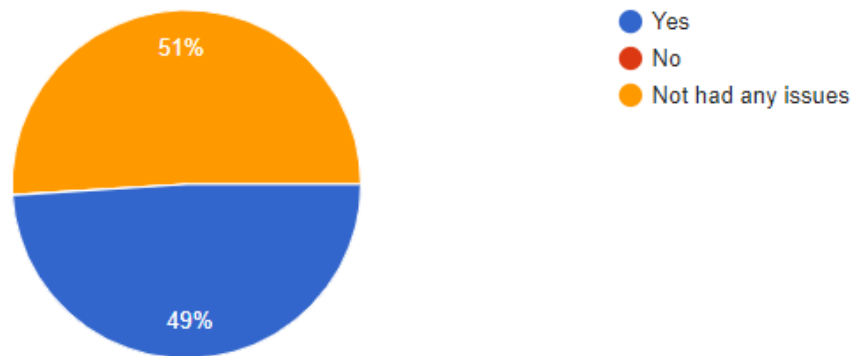

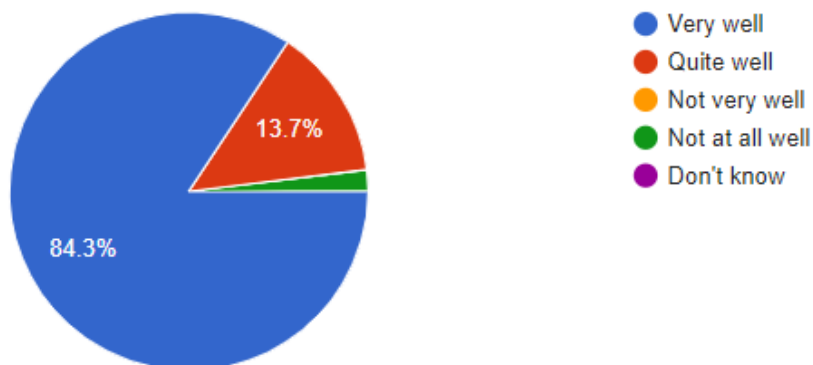
If you have had any issues (home learning, Free School Meal vouchers, children coming in etc) have the school been able to deal with your concerns/issues effectively?
