

# Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter Autumn Term I 2020





### English

This half term we are looking at the book The Iron Man.

We will use the text to write explanation texts on how to catch the Iron Man and a narrative.

Our class novels will include Pebble in My Pocket and Race for Toad Hall.





#### Maths

We will be focusing on place value of numbers within 1000.

We will be counting in Is, 10s and 100s.

We will be representing, comparing and ordering numbers.

We will be adding and subtracting 3 digit and 2 digit numbers

#### Musi

Through the Let Your Spirit Fly' and 'RrB' units of learning, children will learn about RrB and other styles of Music.



<u>Science</u> We will be studying 'Movement & Feeding'. Children will identify that animals need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. Identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.





We will be studying 'Mechanisms-Preumatic Toys'. Children will examine preumatic systems using syringes and balloons then apply their understanding of mechanical systems to create their own preumatic toys.

In World Religion Week, we will be looking at 'Hinduism'. Children will learn the main beliefs; name and describe special festivals and know the meaning of some Hindu alodmya



### Computing

We will be looking at the unit of work Emailing'. Children learn how to send emails with attachments and how to be a responsible digital citizens by thinking about the contents of what they send.



Children will study 'Dodgeball' this half term, learning to apply a broader range of skills and learning how to use them in different ways.



#### History

Children will be studying 'Stone Age to Iron Age'. Children will learn about key events in the Stone Age-Iron Age eras and be able to order key events. Children will make links between people, events and objects.



# Spanish

Children will learn salutations in their first Spanish unit. They will learn to count to 10 as well as colours. Children will learn common classroom commands.
