# Nursery Curriculum Newsletter

## Autumn Term 1 2020



### English

This half term we are looking at the book, 'Leaf Man'.

We will use the text to make our own Leaf Man and begin to mark make using lines and circles.

Our other stories we read will include Red Leaf, Yellow Leaf and We're going on a leaf hunt.



### Maths

We will be concentrating on using number names in our play.

We will be counting up to 10 each day.

We will start to look for shapes in our environment and play with shapes to make arrangements or sort objects by shape and size.

### Expressive Arts-Music

Through the 'Me!' unit, children will learn familiar songs and begin to create sounds by banging, shaking and tapping on musical instruments.



### Knowledge and Understanding of the World-Science

We will be studying 'Animals in Woodland Habitats'. Children will talk about some of the things they have observed such as plants, animals, natural and found objects.



### Expressive Arts-Art

We will be studying Sculpture and Collage through the work of the artist Wassily Kandinsky. The children will work on correct holding position for cutting and sticking.

### Knowledge and Understanding of the World-RE

In World Religion Week, we will be looking at 'New beginnings', by showing an interest in people who are family and friends.



### Knowledge and Understanding of the World-Computing

'Animal Safari and Technology and Me'  
- children will show an interest in technological toys and learn how to switch things on and off and use basic apps.

### Physical Development-PE

Children will study 'Games' this half term, learning to move freely with pleasure and confidence in a range of ways.



### Knowledge and Understanding of the World-Geography
