carnivore animals that mostly eat other animals (meat)

herbivore animals that only eat plants

omnivore animals that eat both plants and other animals

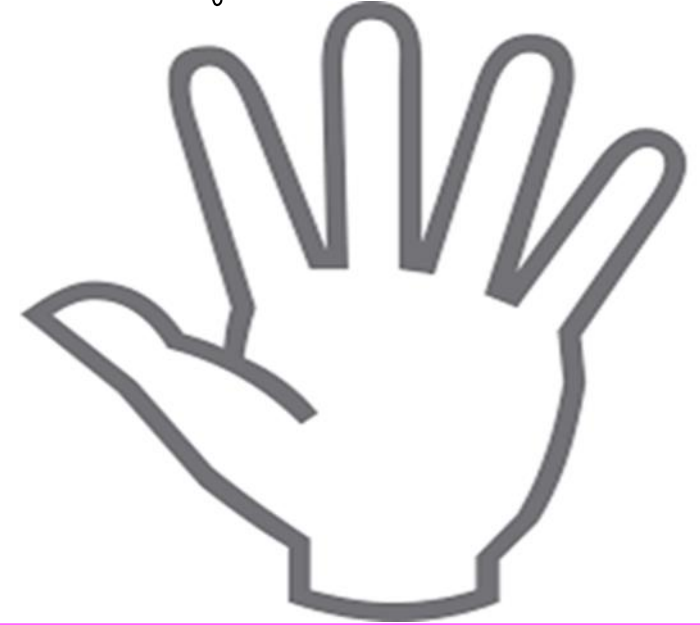
