Key Vocabulary

<u>sight</u> - your eyes let you see all the things around you.


<u>hearing</u> - your ears let you listen to sounds around you.

touch - your skin gives you the sense of touch. you can tell if something is warm, cold, smooth or rough without even looking at it!

<u>taste</u> - your sense of taste comes from your tongue. you can tell if something tastes bitter or sweet. you might have some tastes you like and some you don't.

<u>smell</u> - you smell using your nose. your nose can tell if things smell nice or not

The Power of Four



We have to take care of our bodies. We only get one.

The human body can do so many things: it can bend, run, jump and sleep. It can see hear, smell, taste and touch. It can talk, sing and paint!

We have five senses.

- 1) We smell using our nose.
- 2) We taste using our tongue.
- 3) We touch using parts of our body,
- 4) We see using our eyes.
- 5) We hear using our ears.


