Whole school attendance this week was 96.9% which is amazing. Y1 & Y3 attendance has been greatly impacted by unauthorised holidays. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child should unauthorised holidays continue following a warning.. 202 minutes of missed learning this week for the same children who continue to miss learning due to poor punctuality. 17 children were late this week, several on more than one occasion. 14 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. You are at risk of being fined. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect a visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team to target poor attendance and punctuality.
