Whole school attendance this week was 92.8% which is dropping due to increased absences. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child should unauthorised holidays continue following a warning.. 686 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality. 28 children were late this week, several on more than one occasion. 14 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team.

If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which all will have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.
