Whole school attendance has been very low this week at just 92%. We understand there has been some very genuine sickness across the school but hope children to be well and back in school next Monday. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child should unauthorised holidays continue following a warning. There were 774 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Learning starts at 8.45am. 33 children from 26 families were late this week and some multiple times. 14 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team. If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which all will have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.
