Whole school attendance has improved to 95.8%. We understand there has been some very genuine sickness across the school but hope children to be well and back in school next Monday. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child should unauthorised holidays continue following a warning. There were 314 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Learning starts at 8.45am. 20 children from 14 families were late this week and some multiple times. 14 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team. If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which all will have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.

The children have been exploring a new app this week called Emile. This is to use for home learning and in school. It covers maths, spelling, phonics, grammar and times tables and has been proven to quickly enhance pupils skills in all areas. To stream-



line the apps and websites we use, this will replace TTRS, Numbots and Spelling Shed. Reading Planet and Reading Plus are still to be used. The children are excited about the launch of the new app and it's competitive edge. The leader board will be shared with the children in Celebration Assembly each Friday and certificates and badges will be awarded, just like Numbots and TTRS.

The children have brought home their login details this week. We have entered into a national competition that starts on Monday. We will be awarding prizes in school also.

As always, we encourage regular use of the app and will reward that daily with Class Charts points if your child has used it at home. You can also reward points each time they play.

All Forest School session dates have been sent out via Class Charts. Please make a note of your child's dates so they are suitably dressed for an exciting day of activities


World Book Day
