Whole school attendance has dropped to 93% this week. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child should unauthorised holidays continue following a warning. There were 619 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 23 children from 16 families were late this week and some multiple times. 14 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team.

- If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning, enrichment experiences and time with their friends which all will have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.

Summer Term 1 Extra-Curricular Clubs

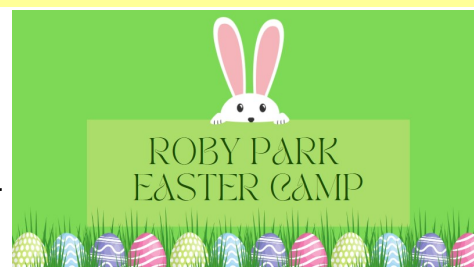
