Whole school attendance has dropped to 93.2% this week. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child should unauthorised holidays continue following a warning. There were 353 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 21 children from 16 families were late this week and some multiple times. 14 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team.

In the Spring term, we launched a Reading competition. Children who had the greatest numbers of words read with 80%+ comprehension would win a shopping spree to Smyths.

Lois Y6 won with a spectacular word count of 70409—55670 more words than our Y5 contender. Samuel Y4 won out of all Y3/4 pupils, with a word count of 32046—17966 more words than the Y3 contender. Lily Y2 won with 17885 words read compared to 7815 from the next contender.
