Whole school attendance has dropped again this week to 94.5% this week. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child. There were 269 minutes of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality. Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. 21 children from 14 families were late this week which is a decline from last week. Please ensure your children do not miss out by being early. 10 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect contact from school and potentially a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team.

This week, we don't have one but two Olympians visiting Roby Park. Olympic bronze medallist, Danny Purvis, will be with us on Tuesday delivering an exciting assembly and then putting children through their paces with a sponsored gymnastics circuit.

GB swimmer, Becky Adlington, who has won 2 Olympic gold and 2 bronze medals will also be joining us this week. On Thursday, Becky will be delivering a water safety assembly to the school. Becky will be sharing some fun facts about her Olympic journey and showcasing her Olympic medals. She will deliver a 15-minute interactive assembly around the importance of water safety. Within this 15 mins would be an opportunity for the children to ask questions too. Children will also receive a free swim session at Swim!
