Another great week! Whole school attendance was 96.3% this week. Holidays will occur warnings and £120 fine per parent per child. **There were 261 minutes/5.35 hours of missed learning this week due to poor punctuality which needs to improve.** Parents/carers need to make sure their children don't fall behind because they are late. Gates open at 8.40am and learning starts at 8.45am. **20 children from 14 families were late this week.** Please ensure your children do not miss out by being early. 10 unauthorised lates in the space of 10 weeks will result in a fixed penalty notice. Please be on time. If your child has repeatedly been late, expect contact from school and potentially a home visit from the Local Authority Attendance Team. **If your child is missing school, they are missing out on learning enrichment experiences and time with their friends which have a negative impact upon their wellbeing.**

We break up at 3pm this Friday for the Whit half term and we return at 8.40am on Monday 3rd June. We hope everybody has a restful and relaxing break ahead of an exciting and final half term of the academic year.
