## WELL DONE Y6 ON YOUR BRILLIANT RESULTS

This week, we were thrilled to receive our brilliant Y6 SATs results which reflect their hard work and dedication. Our results are in line with national or even better and they continue to improve year on year which is a true reflection of the high quality teaching and curriculum at Roby Park. 86% of children achieved age related expectations in Reading compared to 74% of children nationally. 79% of children achieved age related expectations in Writing compared to 72% of children nationally and in Maths 76% of children achieved age related expectations in Reading compared to 73% of children nationally. Children achieving age related expectations in Reading, Writing and Maths combined is 69% whilst nationally results stand at 61%

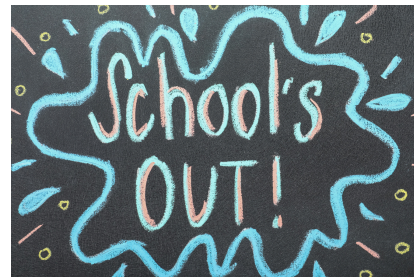
## GOOD LUCK MRS LYONS
