Each week we are asking our children what they have enjoyed about their week at school #missschool #missout

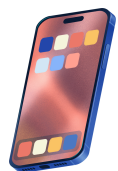
“Wednesday was brilliant because we had Spanish Day. We got to dress up and learn new things in Spanish,” Sophia, Y2.
