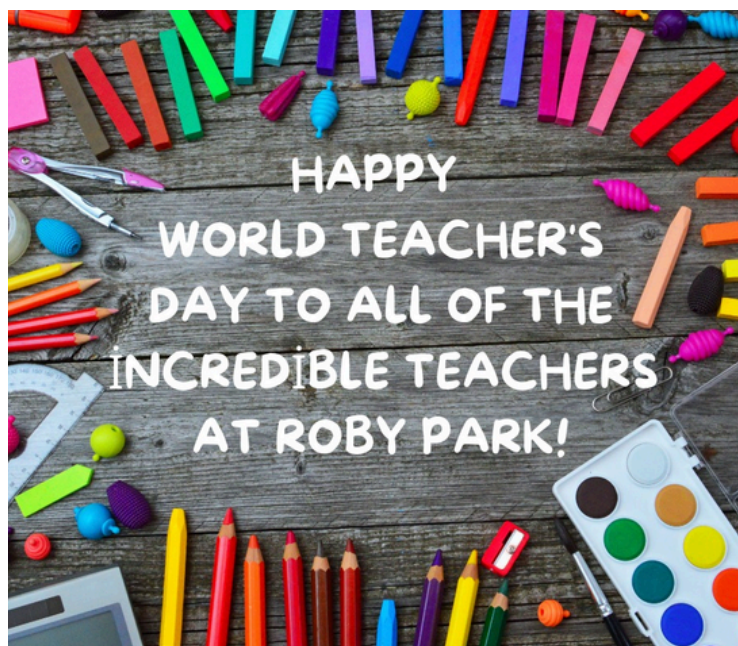

For many young children, transitioning in to Nursery can initially be very overwhelming. To best support our youngest of children, we have decided to change our drop off and pick up arrangements.

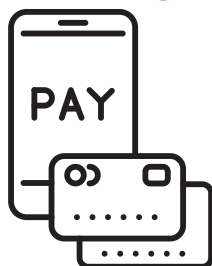

Each week we are asking our children what they have enjoyed about their week at school #missschool #missout

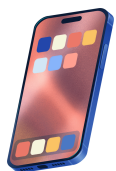
“I have enjoyed Maths this week. We have been learning to counts in 2s, 5s and 10s,”
