- Ensure that all physiological and psychological needs are met
- Be consistent, reliable and provide clear boundaries following our policy
- Be a role model when talking to other adults
- Make facial cues explicit and clear
- Teach calming, breathing and relaxing techniques and model how to regulate emotions
- Acknowledge and validate experiences and feelings of children
- Get to know children well, notice small details, show interest and be curious about change.



- Make references to sensations and match these to a range of emotions
- Provide an inspirational learning environment catering for all needs and abilities
- Provide quiet, safe spaces which children can access when they need them
- Celebrate gifts and talents of children
- Celebrate what makes us unique and special
- Have fun and model playfulness



There will be times when children will need additional support. What does this include at Roby Park Primary School?



- Provide properly resourced safe spaces
- Time out of class to give children a chance to regulate emotions
- Unrelenting support to ensure that all children are able to access learning
- Support to transition smoothly between activities
- Notice about change and activities finishing
- Sensory equipment available
- Acknowledgment that at times children may become overwhelmed and additional time and resources may be needed
