On 19th March, Roby Park proudly completed its final OPAL audit—and not only did we achieve Platinum Status, we scored a perfect 100% in every category!

The audit praised our school for delivering an outstanding and exemplary implementation of the OPAL programme. From strategic leadership to daily practice, the OPAL ethos is embedded across every level of our provision, creating a rich, inclusive, and deeply child-centred play culture that stands as a national model of excellence.

Key highlights from the report include:

- Leadership & Vision: OPAL is a strategic priority, driven by a passionate team including our Headteacher, Curricula Lead for Play, Play Coordinator, Governor and Parent Play Champions, Site Manager, and dedicated Play Team.
- **Empowered Staff:** All supervising staff are trained, visible, and valued, with reflective practice embedded through regular CPD and team meetings.
- **Risk & Freedom:** Children are actively involved in managing risk through the RAPID framework, assemblies, and daily routines—creating a culture of trust, exploration, and independence.
- Playtime Transformation: Free-flow lunchtimes, relaxed routines, and skilled supervision have created a respectful and joyful atmosphere where play is uninterrupted and child-led.



- Incredible Play Spaces: Rewilded natural areas, loose parts, tools, dens, music zones, and performance spaces offer endless opportunities for creativity, connection, and adventure.
- Wholehearted Commitment: From sustainability planning to family engagement, every aspect of our provision reflects a deep and sustained commitment to high-quality play.

This achievement is a testament to our belief that play is not just protected—it's celebrated. At Roby Park, children's right to play is realised in its fullest, most joyful expression.
