YN - Y1 HELP YOUR CHILD THRIVE PROGRAMME

The 'Help Your Child Thrive' programme is coming to Roby Park Primary School on **Thursday 8th January** to help you help your child thrive at school. This 6-session course runs for just over an hour in school, just before you pick your child up at the end of the school day. I'll have the kettle on at 1.45pm!

The course gives you a real insight into what your child is doing in school in Nursery/Reception/Y1 and how you can support learning at home. Each week you'll receive lots of practical tips and ideas as to how to help your child continue to develop skills in communication and language, personal, social and emotional development, physical development, confidence, reading, writing and maths. You will be given a booklet full of resources which shows you the methods being used in school to teach your child so you can support them at home. Our booklet is full of evidence-based tips on useful ways to support children with SEND and parents have found this particularly useful.

The course is really relaxed and open to all parents/grandparents/carers of nursery/reception and Y1. However, places are limited with just 4 places left so be quick to respond! If you'd like to sign up for the course, please fill in the details on the Google Form link by **Tuesday 6th January** and a member of staff will be in contact before the end of term to confirm your place.

All parents/carers who have signed up already, have been sent an Arbor message confirming their places.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR CLUBS
