ACTIVE UNIFORM REMINDER

A polite reminder that all children will be expected to return to school in our new active uniform from the start of the new school year. The current uniform will no longer be accepted.

Please refer to the consultation documents and the Active Uniform Policy for links to the exact approved items and for details of what children must wear when they return to school. All up to date documentation can be found on the website.

School tracksuits can be purchased directly from school, with fortnightly collection times available during term time during the initial transition period. The final collection for this term will be on Wednesday at 3:00pm. There will also be an additional opportunity to collect uniform on 11th August, between 11:00am and 1:00pm.

We ask that all families ensure children return in the correct active uniform. Wearing the correct uniform helps to promote pride, belonging and high standards across school. It also reflects our expectations around behaviour, readiness to learn and representing our school community positively.

It has been wonderful seeing how smart the children look as well as the extremely positive feedback from those who have been wearing their new kit during the hotter weather.

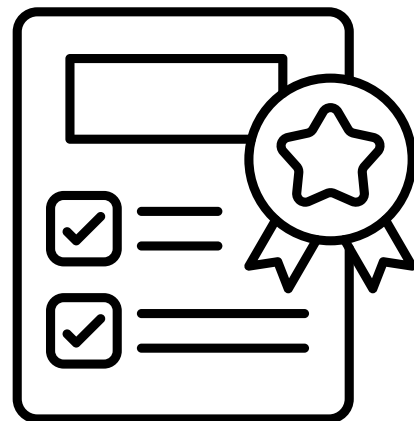


END OF YEAR REPORTS

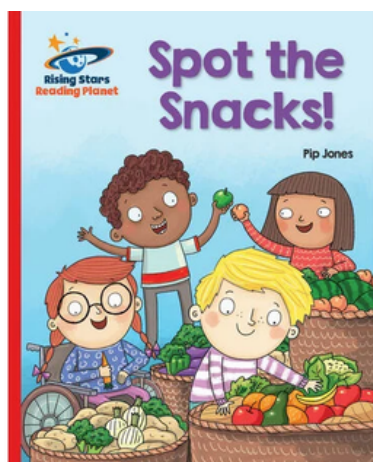
End of year school reports will be sent electronically on Thursday via Insight. Please keep an eye on your emails.
